

World Heritage Ayutthaya Ruins Half-Day Sightseeing + Elephant Riding Experience

Time	Schedule
13:00	<p>Pick up at your hotel to Ayutthaya heritage site</p> <p>*In case of unable to pick up at your hotel, the location will be changed to available places nearby.</p>
14:20	<p>"Wat Yai Chai Mongkol" built by King U-Thong, the first king of the Ayutthaya dynasty</p> <p>This temple was built by King U-Thong, who founded the Ayutthaya dynasty in 1351. The eye-catching pagoda is 72 meters high. This stupa was built to commemorate the victory of 19th King Naresuan in 1592 against a Burmese military prince in single combat. You can climb the pagoda and enjoy the view of the surrounding area. It is a symbolic temple of Ayutthaya, where the reclining Buddha in the precincts and the Buddha statue in the corridor are impressive.</p>
15:00	<p>Visit the Elephant Village (about 10 minutes)</p> <p>Let's gain a new experience with elephant riding with Thai mahout, an activity unique to Thailand. It's a flat road, not in the jungle, so you can rest assured even if it's your first experience.</p>
15:30	<p>"Wat Phra Si Sanphet" where three kings of the Ayutthaya dynasty who left their names in history sleep</p> <p>It is the most important temple within the Ayutthaya Royal Palace, with three Sri Lankan-style pagodas. It is a guardian temple where three kings of the Ayutthaya dynasty who left their names in Thai history sleep, and it is like the Emerald Temple in the Bangkok dynasty. It was destroyed during the Burmese invasion in the 18th century, but was restored after the war, and now only the ruins of the pagoda and pillars remain.</p> <p>"Wat Mahathat" with a Buddha's head taken into the roots of a tree</p> <p>Wat Mahathat, which you will see once in guidebooks. The temple is famous for its impressive wooden Buddha head. The Buddha's head, which fell from the body in the mid-1600s, has been kept horizontal and incorporated into its current form, which is truly a miracle. It is the most popular temple in Ayutthaya tourism.</p>
17:00	<p>Return to Bangkok</p>
